Beach Conditions

The Captiva Erosion Prevention District (CEPD) continues to monitor the beaches and fish kills. We are again seeing dead fish along the bay side. Lee County was called today and they will send contractors tomorrow to continue the removal of the dead fish from our back bay waters.

A 4-yard dumpster is still in place at the Alison Hagerup Beach Parking Lot, with another being added at The Green Flash Waterfront Restaurant on a temporary basis. We appreciate any assistance from visitors and residents who have been bagging dead fish in an effort to keep our beaches beautiful.
