2019 Physical Monitoring Survey

This week our 2019 Physical Monitoring Survey will begin on the beach of Captiva.

Our engineering firm, APTIM, will be conducting their Year 5 Survey (from the 2013/14 Beach Renourishment). Rest assured that this survey is a passive operation; the public may see the crew walking the beach with handheld GPS equipment and a boat in the nearshore waters. The boat may come close to the beach at times, but the captain is highly experienced with these operations and follows strict safety protocols.

They will only be here for a few days. We thank you for your patience - this is a requirement after every renourishment.
