## Alison Hagerup Beach Park Scheduled to Reopen

Lee County Parks and Recreation has informed the Captiva Erosion Prevention District office that Alison Hagerup Beach Park will be ready to open to the public as early as this Saturday, March 11<sup>th</sup>. The CEPD is working to ensure the proper staff and facilities are available as soon as possible.

The CEPD reminds all visitors to follow Lee County laws and guidance when visiting Captiva's beaches. Normal parking rates apply. \$25 for 2 hours and \$40 for all day. Parking Proceeds are applied directly to beach nourishment and the enhancement of wildlife habitat. ## BEACH ETIQUETTE

- · NO Live Shelling
- A valid Florida fishing license is required to fish.
- · Poles must be attended at all times.
- Dogs are not allowed on Captiva beaches.
- Stay off dune vegetation and avoid nesting shore birds and sea turtles.
- Recycle and dispose of trash and fishing line properly.
- · Alcoholic beverages are prohibited.
- No open fires.
- Respect your neighbors and wildlife: Play music at a low volume; no nude sunbathing allowed.
- · Leave nothing on the beach but your footprints.
